## RESOLUTION TO JOIN IN COMPLAINT TO STATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND ATTORNEY GENERAL REGARDING LAKE GEORGE WATERKEEPER

WHEREAS, the Lake George Waterkeeper has submitted letters, correspondence and/or reports to the Town Board, Town Planning Board and/or Town Zoning Board of Appeals in reference to various projects and activities occurring within the Town; and

WHEREAS, some of these letters, correspondence and reports were submitted during the years 2008 and 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Waterkeeper signed some or all of these documents with the letters "P.E.", presumably indicating his status as a licensed Professional Engineer in the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Town Board that the Waterkeeper may not in fact have been a licensed Professional Engineer during these years; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board understands that it is unlawful for an individual to misrepresent his or her status as a licensed professional in the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board understands that the Town Board of the Town of Lake George will be lodging a formal complaint to the New York State Department of Education and/or New York State Attorney General regarding this possible misrepresentation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bolton Town Board hereby joins in this Complaint by the Lake George Town Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Supervisor, Town Counsel and Town Zoning Officer are authorized and directed to provide copies of documents received by the Town of Bolton from the Waterkeeper to the Town of Lake George to assist in any inquiry or investigation.
